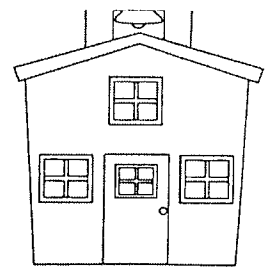

## Kindergarten Supply List



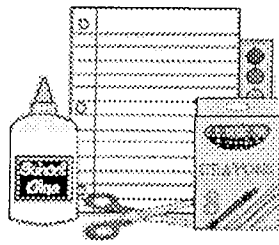
- (2) Large Bottle of Elmer's White Glue (Lawson & Ivey Only)
- (6) Jumbo Elmer's Glue Sticks
- (4) Boxes of Crayola Crayons (16 or 24 pack)
- Fiskar Scissors (no safety scissors)
- 12 pk of #2 Wooden Yellow Pencils (no pretty pencils)
- (1) pk Pencil Top Erasers
- (2) Pink Pearl Erasers
- (1) 4 pk Expo Dry Erase Markers (back, fine point)
- (2) Polypro Folders with Pockets at Bottom (no paper folders)
- Pencil Box (no bags & boxes, must be able to fit in desk)
- Backpack (large enough for folders)
- (1) Box of Kleenex
- (4) Clorox Wipes
- (1) Hand Sanitizer 30 oz.
- (1) Red & Blue Mat (Lawson Only)
- (1) Ziploc Bag (sandwich)
- (1) Ziploc Bag (gallon)
- (1) pk White Copy Paper
- (1) pk Colored Copy Paper
- (1) pk Construction Paper (multicolor)
- (1) pair Clean White Socks (to use as erasers)

## First Grade Supply List

**\*\*Please put your child's name on their personal supplies. This will help them keep track of what is theirs!\*\***

1. A backpack
2. One pack of #2 pencils (mechanical pencils are not allowed in the classroom)
3. Box of 24 Crayola Crayons
4. Small plastic crayon/pencil box or pouch
5. Three or four glue sticks (Please do not buy the liquid glue. It is messy and takes longer to dry.)
6. Scissors and erasers (block type and pencil top)
7. One box of Kleenex/Puffs tissues
8. One bottle of Germ-X
9. **THREE large containers** of Clorox or Lysol Wipes (We use these on a daily basis to clean our desks and the room so we go through them quickly!)
10. Two **PLASTIC** (2- pocket) folders—*Please* buy the plain plastic folders **without** the metal fasteners inside. *One folder will be used as a homework folder and the other as a weekly folder.* Plastic folders will last longer than the paper kind.
11. 1 pack of Expo markers (**black**).

2nd Grade Supply List**

1. Regular **Wide Ruled** notebook paper (2 packs)
2. Three packs of **#2** pencils
3. 2 boxes of **24** Crayola Crayons (**You might want to buy some extra packs of crayons while they are on sale. The children break and lose them pretty fast.**)
4. **Three** or **four** glue sticks
5. Scissors (**Fiskars** -**blunt tip** are very good) **optional**
6. Three **Large** boxes of Kleenex/Puffs tissues
7. **School supply pouch - w/ three holes to place in notebook** (No pencil boxes)
8. Two large block pink eraser
9. **Two** bottles of **Waterless Soap (Germ-x)**
10. One **1-inch** notebook w/ pockets
11. A large box of **Clorox Wipes or Lysol Wipes**
12. **One Composition book** for math and reading journal writings. (*The kind we like is **usually** black and white speckled; however, sometimes they come with a cartoon character on them like Garfield. **They usually have 100 sheets of wide-ruled paper and are not spiral bound.***)
